hold it for you. Also, remember we are computerized so we can look up any book you are searching for in all our inventories – with just one phone call. If no requests for books by the weekend, they go on the shelves for sale to the general public.

Another little tidbit; I think everyone knows Gillian Flynn is a new author whose book 'Gone Girl' is being made into a movie. You might also like to know she has written another book 'Dark Places' which is also being made into a movie at this moment and, of course, we have it in stock. I would also like to emphasize we are always on the lookout for children's books. Something else I want to again mention is we really want adult fiction talking books, or stories on CD. People who drive a lot will find they can follow a story quite easily, even if they only drive for small amours of time - each time. So again, please bring yours in and I will give you as much as I can for them – in cash, of course.

A word about buying books. When you bring in books you want to sell to that are not ours, we always look for the copyright date. Recent publications – 2013 or 2014 - are what we are looking for. When a book is older than that, we could very possibly already have it in stock in at least one of our locations. Also, please remember we are doubled up on books in all locations, so we have to be very particular about what we buy. What we almost always refuse are old best-sellers. Either we have it or we have an awful lot of books by the same author. If we were not limited by space than we could fill in all the gaps of best-selling books and complete their collections – but we don't have that luxury. So a word of warning, we will probably not be interested in those books.

We hope by sending you this informative letter on a regular

basis, you will find it beneficial. If not, and you really don't want to be on our list of preferred customers, please let us know and we will take you off our mailing list right away.

We have decided not to attached a trailer of a new movie made from a best selling book because the attachment is very big and some people have had problems opening them.
